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

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#### HOW TO BLESS YOUR OWN ANCESTOR MONEY

Recite any of the mantras used in this art work at least 21 times or 108 times then <u>dedicate the merit</u> from reciting these mantras to your Ancestors.

In the Cambridge Dictionary, the word Dedicate means: - To give all your energy and time.

In the context of dedicating merit to Ancestors it simply means: - You are giving any and all merit, fruits or benefits derived from the use of these divine prayers to the benefit of your Ancestors.

Some people recite these mantras and <u>dedicate the merit</u> just before they burn the Ancestor Money and offer the fruit or food to their Ancestors. This is one of the simplest ways you can bless your own Ancestral offerings to send more energy to your Ancestors.

Do not underestimate this simple practice. The Wish Fulfilling mantra alone clearly states that merely seeing this mantra purifies 100 million eons of negative karma, so imagine reciting it 108 times (1 Japa mala) and dedicating the merit from this to your Ancestors. Once you uphold the 5 Precepts this guaranteed to help your Ancestors.

### BASIC GUIDELINES FOR JOSS PAPER

In most Chinese traditions they have their Altar inside the home for the Jade Emperor and the other Gods. After prayer to the Gods and making food offering to the Ancestors they traditionally the burn Joss Papers and Ancestor Money; outside, in-front of their homes.

Their cultural belief is the wind will carry the ashes of the burnt offerings away, and this is what they use as an indication that their offering has been accepted.

Your Ancestor Altar should be set lower than your Altar for the Gods. The Ancestral Altar consists of a simple pan for burning Ancestor Money and a daily glass of water, cooked food or fruit offerings can also be placed there daily or weekly.

It is up to you to add photos of your Ancestors and personal belongings of them on that Altar; you can also put Rum and Tobacco on that Altar for them. You can also put a little Tobacco in the Ancestor Money and burn it as an offering. The best type of rum to use is clear Gin.

### BASIC OFFERINGS TO THE JADE EMPEROR

The Altar for the Jade Emperor and other Gods whom you worship should be higher than the Ancestral Altar.

You can offer flowers or fruits of any kind to the Jade Emperor, and replace them anytime they show signs of decay or rotting. A favourite offering to the Jade Emperor is Sugar cane with the stalk.

There is a story about some farmers who were going through extreme hardship, they had nothing to offer to the Jade Emperor. All they had was Sugar cane, since that time, using Sugar cane with the stalk became a tradition.



#### SPECIAL PAPER TO HONOR THE GODS

This is the Joss Paper to offer for the Gods, use this to give thanks and honour to them. I was told to burn this 6 stacks at a time and just give thanks to the Gods.

Or you can write your full name, date of birth and address BEHIND this paper (No wishes to be written on this paper). Sincerity is what matters most.

Due to the lack of Joss Paper in my part of the world, I just use 6 sheets at a time.



# PAPER FOR MAKING PRAYER REQUESTS / WISHES / LONGEVITY

This Paper represents Longevity, and blessings; it is commonly used for making requests and wishes to the Gods. You can simply pray with the paper in your hands and verbally make your request to them. Or, you can write your (1) WISH, (2) Name, (3) Date of birth and (4) Address BEHIND this paper.

I was advised to use 6 stacks at a time, due to the lack of Joss Paper in my part of the world, I just use 6 sheets at a time.

You can just write 1 wish, but do not write more than 3 wishes at a time. The paper for Gods and the paper for making wishes should be burned separately.



On special occasions, fold Joss Paper and Ancestor money into shape of an arrowhead, or dagger before burning and request cutting of spiritual cords to release you from negative bonds that do not serve you anymore while burning. This is best done on Full Moon Night or during solar or lunar eclipse.

You can also smear inside the Joss Paper offerings with honey, Patchouli oil and Dragon's blood and any other ingredients that you feel will give more value to the offering. (Note dragon's blood is derived from the sap in certain types of trees and has been used for hundreds of years.)

### **GUI REN PAPER**

#### For removing negativity and bring Business

When I visited Singapore, I got a large bag of this particular Joss Paper as a gift, the only instruction I was given was. Burn 1 Joss paper to destroy negativity and the other Joss Paper will attract business. There are many other papers that are very similar to this, therefore; at this time I am presenting only these 2 types of Gui Ren Paper.

Gui Ren Paper is used together with other joss paper to pray for help and assistance from Deities. Gui Ren is a term used to describe a form of "seen" or" unseen" assistance from your surroundings.

You can burn every day or on the 1st and 15th of the month (Follow Chinese Calendar).


Write your name, date of birth and address in front of the Red paper, and burn in multiples of odd numbers.



The Red Gui Ren Paper is for Wealth, Prosperity, attract business, Job and good relationships with people in your life.

The Yellow Gui Ren Paper is for Health, Longevity and destroying negativity.

The 3 Gods on the yellow paper are said to be 3 Ancient Star Lords, and are mandated to take care of beings in Heaven, Hell and Earth. It must be filled out as described below to achieve maximum benefits.



Some masters say we should simply write the information at the back of the paper. At the end, you have to do your research and decide the best way to use this paper, I have tried my best to present the use of this in the simplest way possible.

The only way this will work for you is if you use it with extreme respect and do not get greedy, be respectful and uphold the 5 Precepts in your daily life.

### **REBIRTH PAPER FOR THE ANCESTORS**

Apart from traditional Hell Notes/ Ancestor Money, there is Re-Birth Paper. Many Buddhists express that burning joss papers with Mantras are totally useless. However there are some of these same Buddhist temples that sell these Joss Papers for Liberation.

This type Joss Paper presented here is Re-birth Joss Paper and contains 7 different types of mantras for Liberation.

There are many arguments that are both for and against the use of Joss Papers with mantras written on them. At the end it is entirely up to you to decide if you want to use this, and if you see any benefit by using it for your Ancestors.

I recommend that you attempt to learn the mantras and recite then when making offerings for your ancestors.



# THE MANDATE OF HEAVEN

# "Revere Heaven and Serve thy People" The Most Powerful Seal ever carved for the Kangxi Emperor, The Greatest and Longest-reigning Monarch of China

Seal of the Mandate of Heaven is unusual among Qing imperial seals as it testifies to the close correspondence between Kangxi's philosophical ideals and his deeds as emperor.

The way that all Emperors in China dressed themselves were to emulate the Jade Emperor.

The seal was so important that during Kangxi's reign it was at all times kept in a very clean place at the Palace, also the Seal was present where the Emperors did their policy-making.

His son and grandson the Yongzheng and Qianlong Emperors, together with Kangxi, were the three greatest Emperors of the Qing dynasty, and they all had identical seals carved as they believed that the Imperial motto would bestow authority and blessing onto their reign. This one seal has been used by three generations and has yielded an unlimited amount of blessings on the realm.

#### The Mandate of Heaven – Key to Legitimacy & Emperorship

The Mandate of Heaven (tianming) is the philosophical tenet that Heaven granted emperors the right to rule based on their ability to govern and their righteousness and was used throughout the history of China to validate and legitimize the rule of the emperors of China.

According to this belief, Heaven will only bestow its mandate to a just and virtuous ruler, the Son of Heaven. Otherwise, the Mandate and thus his right over his kingdom and subjects will be forfeited in favour of someone better qualified.

The overthrow of an emperor was often interpreted as the loss of the Mandate of Heaven. The kings of the Zhou dynasty first used the

concept of the Mandate of Heaven to legitimize their rule and the overthrow of the earlier Shang dynasty.
